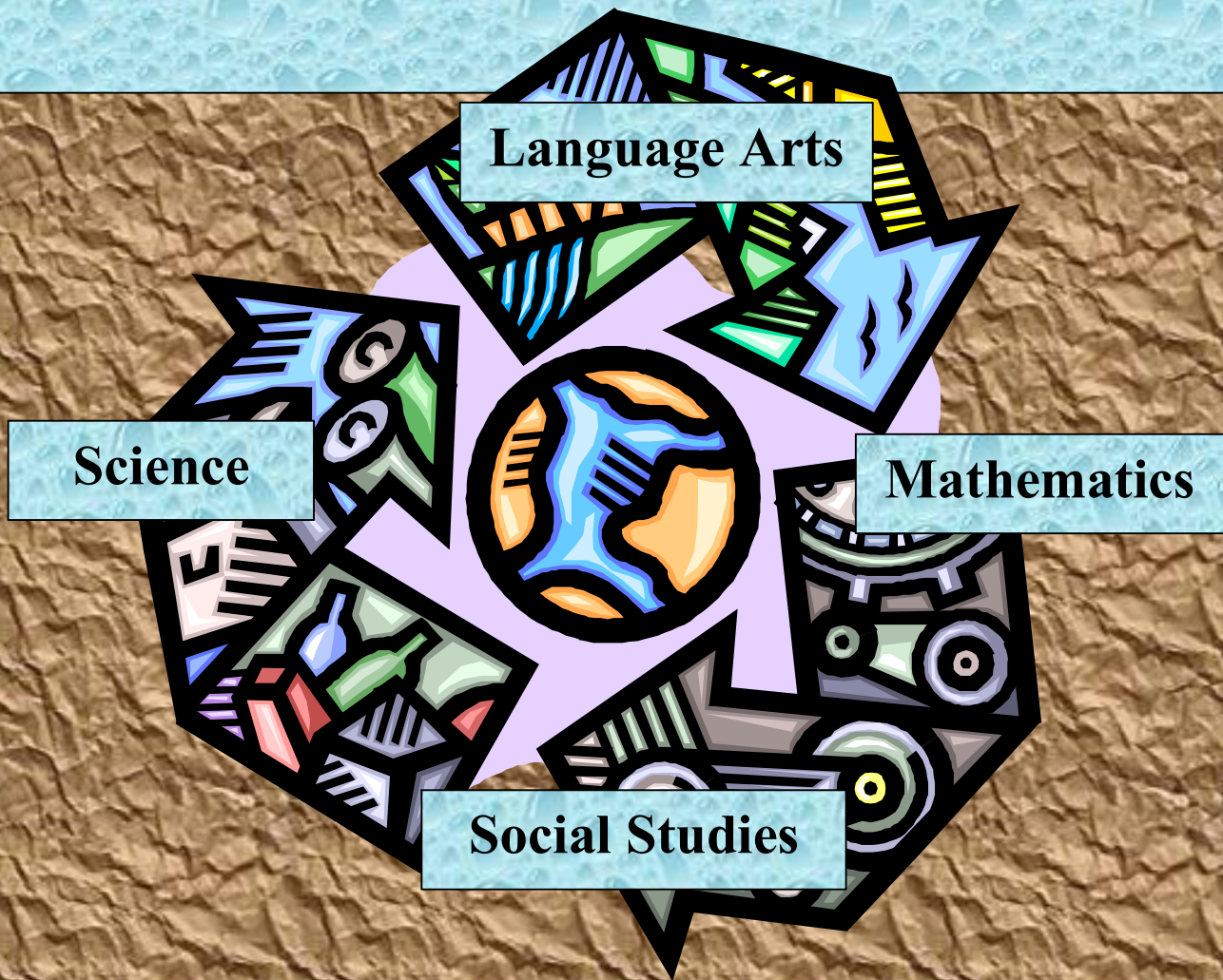

Creating Trash Sculptures**

Objective:

Students will create a sculpture made from trash.

Materials:

Various pieces of clean trash

Opener:

Show some pieces of trash. Have the students think about what they might do with it.

Activity:

Using the trash that you have recently sorted and analyzed, create a sculpture. Be creative. You do not have to use the trash as it is. You can cut, tear or fold it. You might want to add other pieces of trash or other art mediums.

Closure:

Share the art pieces in an art show.
