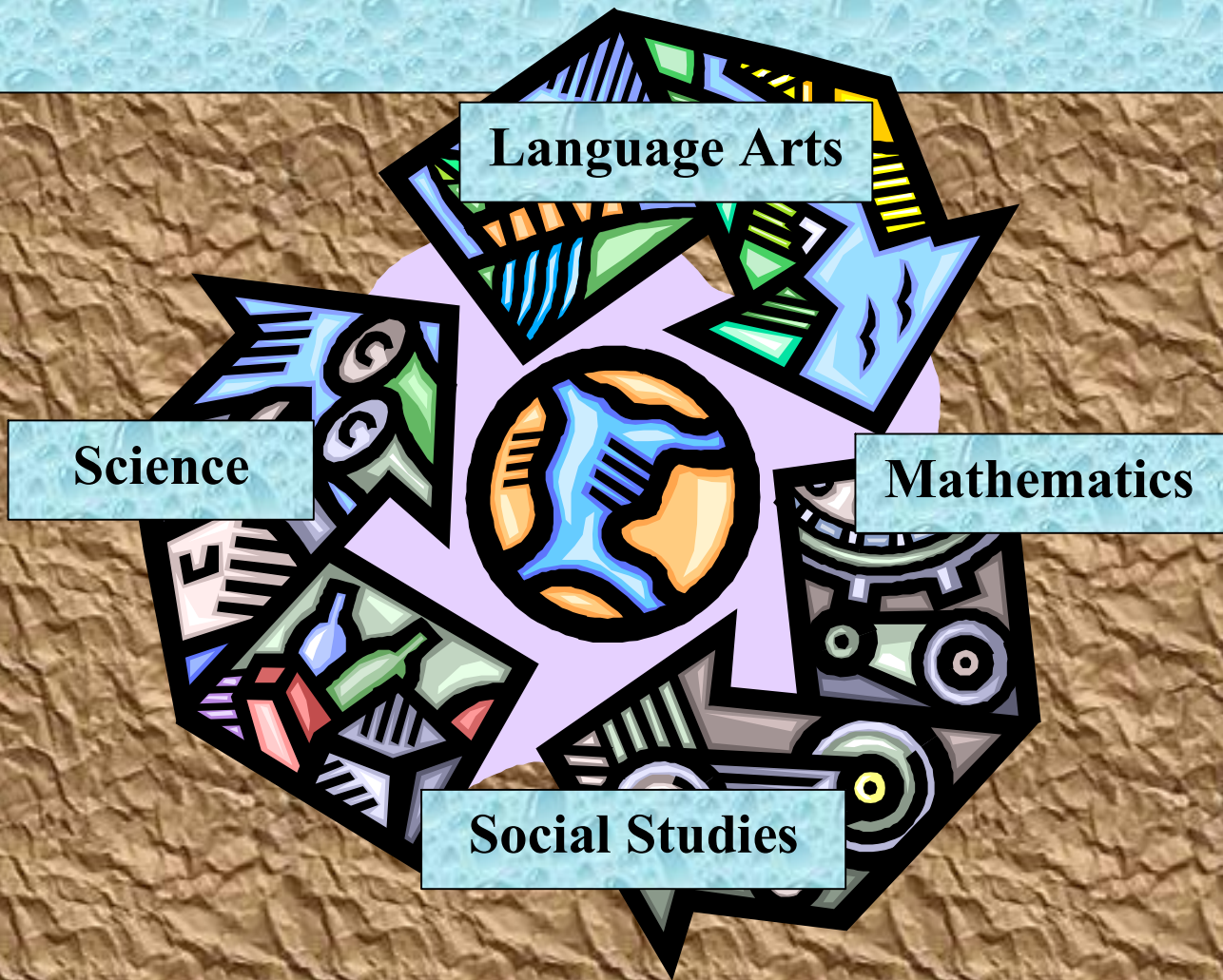

### Lesson 5, Worksheet 5 Creating a Frequency Table

**Objective:**

Students will create a frequency table of the recyclable items.

**Materials:**

**Directions:**

- 1) On the chart below are several categories of recyclable material. Can you think of more? Place them in the remaining column headings.
  
- 2) Under each correct column, write the names of the trash item. For example, a soda pop can would be placed under metal. Instead of writing the name of the trash item, you could put a tally mark. Some items cannot be recycled. Most recyclable items have a recyclable label on them. (Look at the simple below. It is the recyclable symbol.)
